School Board Governance

SUBJECT: LAY COMMITTEE

A lay committee is a committee that is composed of members other than Board members or BOCES administrators. However, the Greater Southern Tier BOCES Board President may appoint a BOCES administrator or Board member to the lay committee after the committee has been formed to act as a liaison with the Board.

The Board may appoint lay committees to serve as advisory bodies.

Lay committees shall be temporary and will be dissolved upon the accomplishment of the purpose for which they are established.
