SUBJECT: CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION DAY ADULT ENROLLMENT

It is the view of the Greater Southern Tier BOCES Board that opportunities for lifelong learning should be enhanced. A goal of the Board is to encourage adult enrollment in daytime occupational programs where space is available.

Secondary students will always have priority over adults for enrollment in Career and Technical Education programs. By comparing the estimated secondary daytime enrollment with class size maximums, BOCES administrators will establish how many adults could potentially attend each class.

Any adults who attend these classes will be charged a tuition of at least 50% of the tuition equivalent for secondary students. The tuition will be determined annually by the District Superintendent or his designee. The tuition amounts due are payable in advance of each quarter.

No costs will be assigned to our component school districts as a result of this reduced tuition policy.

The selection of adult students will be based on screening performed by BOCES.
